one of my roommates walked in with a stunned look on his face. He asked if I could drive him to the hospital. He explained that his fiancée had been in a car accident. She and her younger sister had been driving to the hospital to visit their father who was dying of cancer when the accident occurred. Her sister did not

survive. It is difficult to imagine a more tragic situation.

After hours at the hospital I dropped my friend off at his future in-laws' house. He was exhausted. I will never forget what he said to me. "Be still, and know that I am God." The Holy Spirit had brought these powerful words from Psalm 46 to his mind in the hour of his greatest need. He could not possibly imagine why the LORD would have allowed such a tragedy to occur. He was completely powerless to fix it or make it all better for his fiancée and her family. All he could do is be still...and remember that God was in control. What a difficult thing to do! We are so convinced that we are in control of our lives, that we are masters of our own fates. But...we...are...not. There is only One who is in control. There is only One who is God. And we are not him.

But that is alright. It is better than alright. It is a sigh of relief to our anxious hearts. Who better to be in control than the One who loved us enough to give us his one and only Son to live and die for our sins? Who better to be in control than the One who conquered death when he rose from the grave?

Whatever burdens your heart this day, whatever causes you anxiety or worry or stress – be still, and know that the Lord Almighty is God. And he loves you; he forgives you; he cares about you. And he is all the God vou will ever need.
